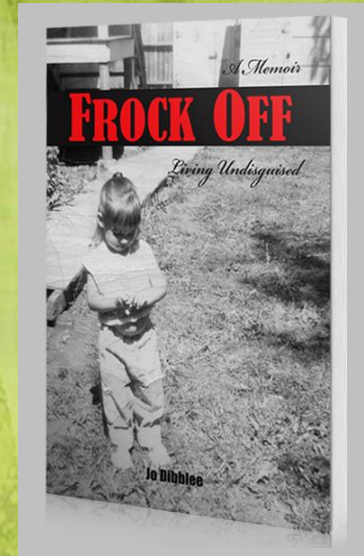
Join us in celebration for a book signing and presentation!
